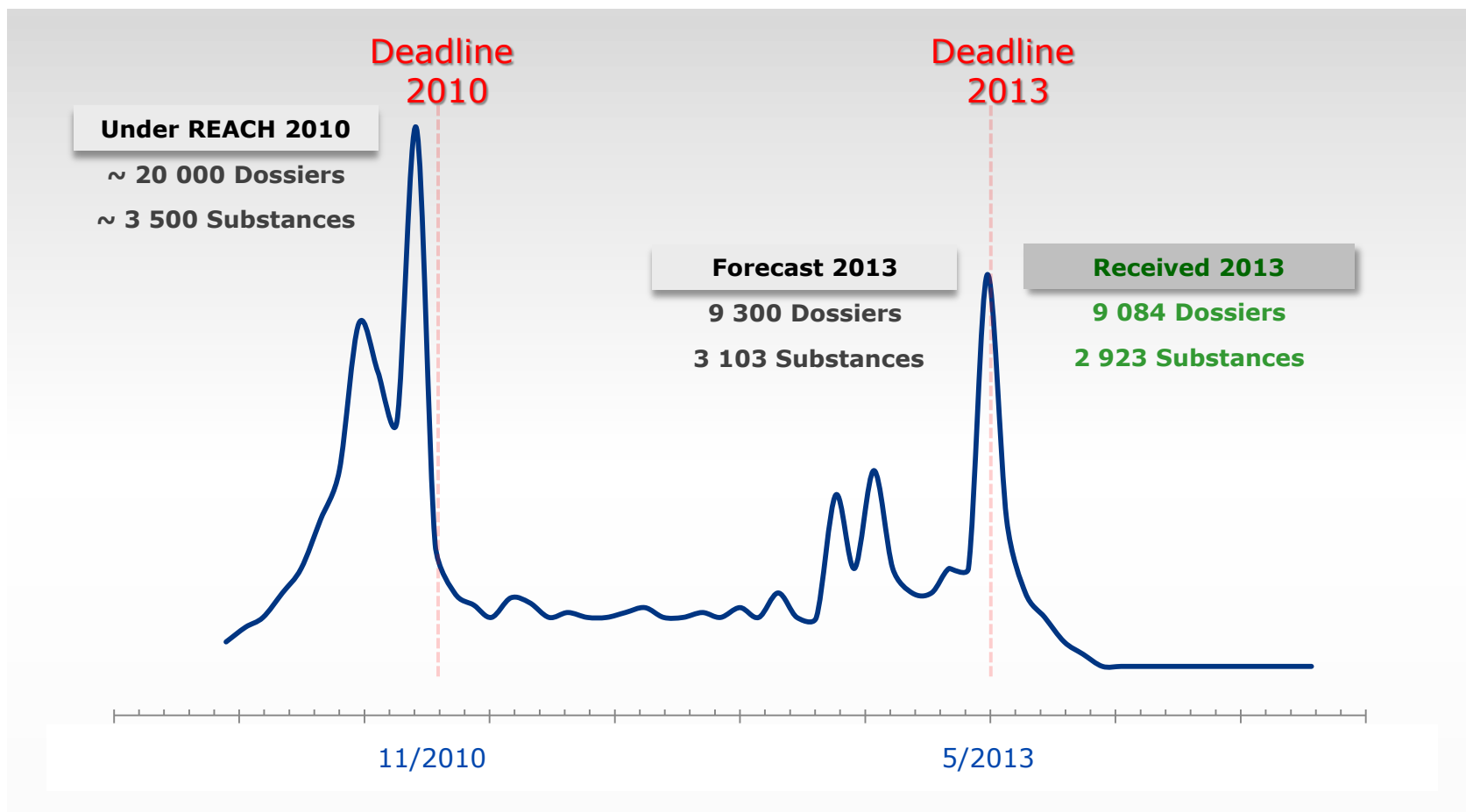

## Highlights

- **9 084** registrations received for the 2013 deadline
- **2 923** more substances registered since 2010
- 10 DCG issues opened to support registrants
- 6 Data sharing disputes processed in “contingency”
- 6 598 chemicals registered since the start of REACH  
- REACH is working!

# Dossiers and Substances – overview

## Comparison with forecast

- Numbers fully in line with the forecast
- Difference in the substances registered
  - around 1000 announced by industry but not registered
  - around 800 registered but not announced
- Possible reasons?
  - Shifts in business
  - Registration postponed to 2018 whenever possible
  - Business strategy of not informing ECHA
- ✓ No concern from DUs or trade association reported to ECHA

## Only Representatives

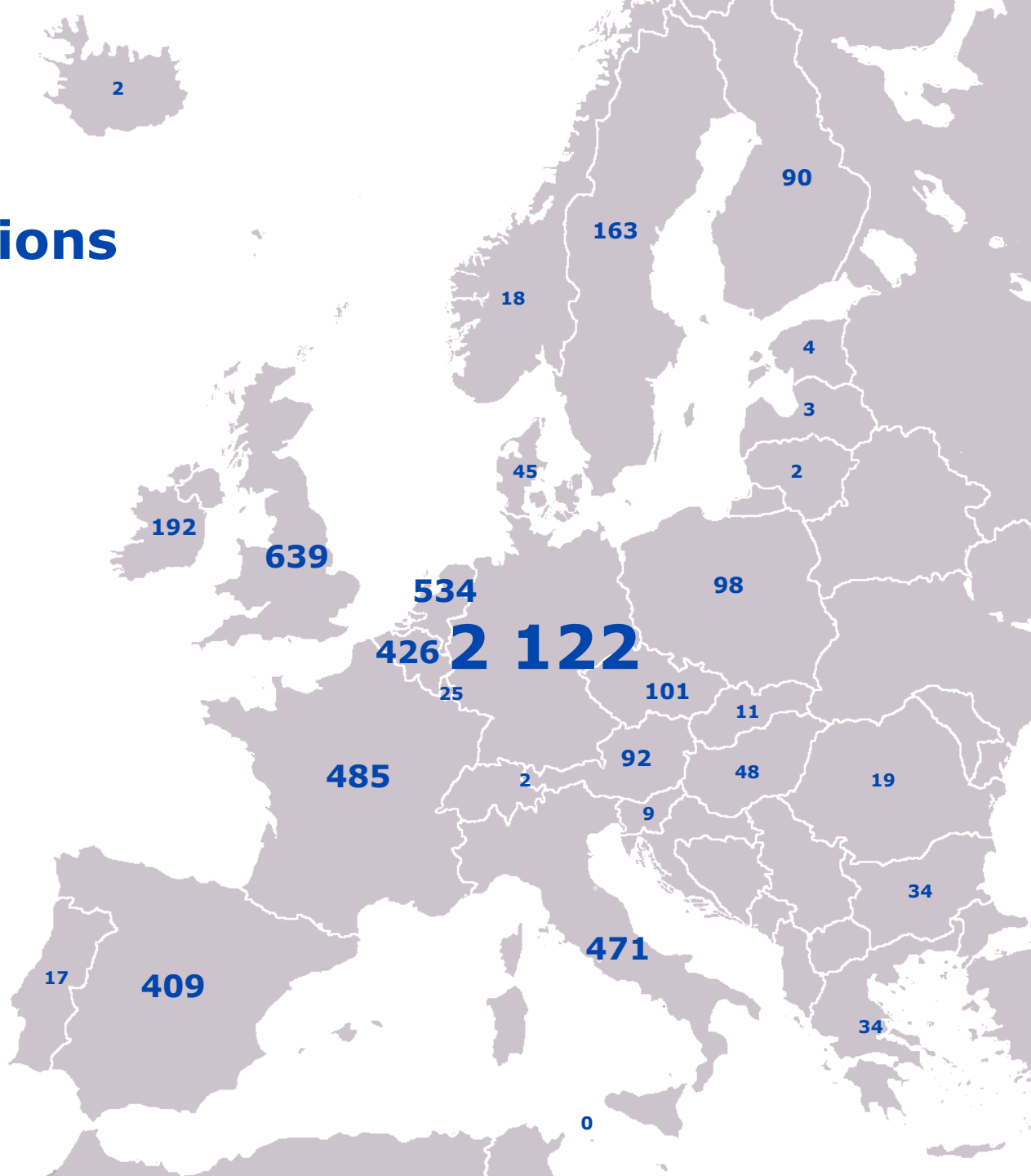
Role in the supply chain	%

Only Representative of a non-EU manufacturer	23%

*Non-EU companies can export to the European Union through two different routes under REACH: either via an importer who has registered the substance, or by appointing an Only Representative.*

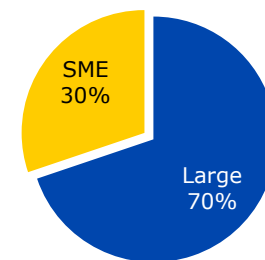

## Company Support

- File Format, Virus Check, XML Check
  - 126 failures in May - 50 companies helped
- Business Rules failures
  - 1 163 errors – support in 50% cases
  - 425 companies contacted by phone or email
- Helpdesk Incidents in May
  - 425 related to the 2013 deadline (of which 60% were blocked accounts)
- DCG Issues = exceptional cases preventing companies acting in good faith from registering
  - 10 valid cases

## Next steps for ECHA

- Conclude completeness checks on all dossiers
- Publish final numbers in September 2013
- Contact lead registrants that have not registered
- Publish information from dossiers online

## Screening activities

- Draft Multi-Annual Work Programme 2014-2018
- Targeted screenings
  - Intermediates
  - Substance identity
- Dossier Quality Assistant
  - Helps you tackle inconsistencies
  - Update dossier spontaneously, if needed



## Next steps for industry

- Registrants
  - Prepare safety data sheets for clients in the supply chain
    - registration numbers
    - exposure scenarios giving advice on safe use
  - Keep information up-to-date
- Downstream users
  - Verify if substances and uses are registered
  - If not, action needed

## **We can be proud!**

- ca. 6 600 substances registered since 2008
- ECHA dissemination website is to become the biggest public regulatory database of chemicals
- Information flowing in the supply chain
- Informed decisions being taken by companies
- Aim of REACH gradually being achieved
