IUCLID



Current version: IUCLID5.4.1

Major changes of the format / data model:

- New mandatory section on PBT assessment (section 2.3)
- Manufacture, Use and exposure (section 3)
- Update of Endpoint Summaries in section 6 and 7

Other functionalities added e.g.:

- Bulk user creation or update
- Group of IUCLID documents / Folder structure
- → See release notes in installation package for details on changes
- 5.4.1. maintenance release in October: fixed some bugs and additional improvements (Java 7 support)

IUCLID: the future



IUCLID5.5:

- Integration of Biocidal Products Information
- Generation of hyperlinks to facilitate exchange of info between users
- Show differences between new-old dossier
- Option to reduce size of dossiers (no duplication of attachments)
- Some other minor improvements e.g. literature inventory export/print options
- Compatibility with 5.4 ensured for REACH data
- Final release expected by the end of Q1-2013; testing ongoing

IUCLID6:

- Different architectures for different organisations (small/medium/large)
- Collection of user requirements by OECD IUCLID Expert panel
- Release expected by the end of 2014?

IUCLID tips



- → Plan integration with other company systems e.g. EHS
- → Define clear user management rules and don't use personal user names
- → Be careful when you share IUCLID files with other companies in the SIEF e.g. LR to provide dossier, remove company-specific data!
- → Be aware of new releases (migration may be unavoidable!):
 - migration takes time and may bring errors
 - make sure you have back-ups before migrating
 - Test! Use production data for testing
 - Read FAQ
- → If you use servide providers: make sure you get the IUCLID datasets and users/passwords for REACH-IT

IUCLID plug-ins



CSR plug-in to IUCLID:

- Will be updated to generate CSR from IUCLID and Chesar
- Verify consistency between Risk Assessment and substance properties
- Fill in use and exposure information in IUCLID (e.g. list of uses)
- Publication expected by the end of the year

TCC, dissemination and fee calculator: a MUST before submission:

- Ensuring your dossier will pass Business Rules and ECHA checks
- Verification that no confidential information will be disseminated
- Calculation of the fee to be paid to ECHA upon submission
- → Tip: verify latest plug-in versions before running them

REACH-IT



Latest update:

- 'The' submission portal to ECHA
- Developments currently focused on new legislations: Biocides, Prior Informed Consent (PIC)
- New release (end November) includes:
 - Improvement of the inquiry workflow: lower processing times expected
 - Extension of cease / restart manufacture functionality to new dossier types
 - Joint Submission Object changes e.g. possibility to leave JS before submission
 - Substance in Article Web form
 - Co-Registrants Page (CoRP) (see next)

The future:

- De-coupling from IUCLID updates
- Simplification of submission processes
- ...
- → Industry wish list for REACH-IT improvements
- → Discussed in the ECHA Industry users group

REACH-IT: tips



- → Activate option to receive mail alerts if new messages in REACH-IT (in general settings)
- → Decide how your company will organise access to REACH-IT and create user accounts
- → Fill in REACH-IT account details wisely: who will be the contact point for ECHA for each process
- → Be aware of 'down times' via ECHA news for your submission plan: watch out for Christmas break!

Dissemination



- New fields are now disseminated from the registration dossiers: company names, registration numbers, etc.
- Make sure you check information that will be disseminated:
 - For new submissions
 - For previously submitted dossiers including NONs

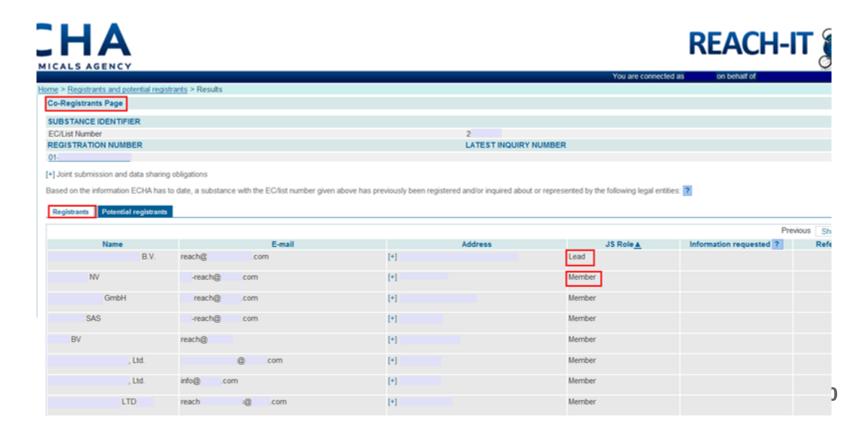
And introduce confidentiality claims if necessary!

Use Dissemination and Fee calculator plug-ins!

Co-registrants page



- Puts in contact registrants and inquirers of the same substance
- Highlights who is the LR, who is outside of the Joint submission, two LRs for same substance, etc.
- Gives real-time information on newcomers

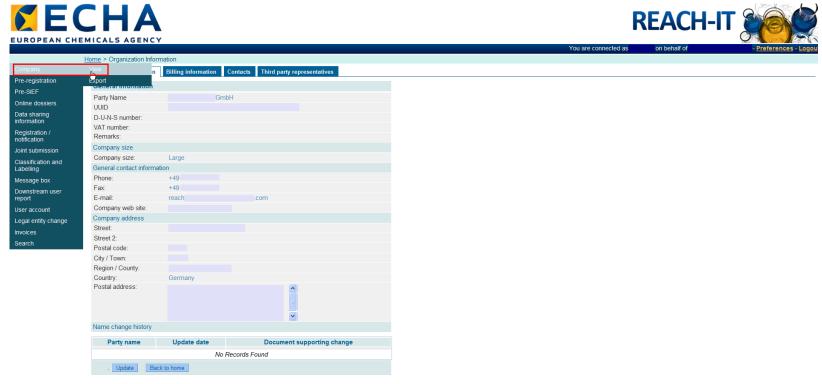


Co-registrants page (cont.)



→ Tip: check few of your substances to understand which email address appears on this platform and update if necessary!

Screenshot to show where ECHA takes contact details:



→ Tip: if you have claimed your company name confidential, check the identity is not disclosed in this page, appoint TPR!

tCCH (IT screening of dossiers)



- ECHA has started to use IT tools to screen dossiers for quality
- These tools screen ALL dossiers
- Complements the 'normal' dossier evaluation. Outcome is manually verified, before compliance letters are sent (CCH letters have 30d to react).
- Areas of concern within dossiers will be very likely to be spotted
- → Tip: Keep an eye on your REACH-IT mailbox, some requests have very tight deadlines!!
- → Tip: if you receive a communication of compliance, check if other dossiers need update too!

Biocides



ECHA will have a central role in the implementation of BPR in 2013:

- R4BP (Register for Biocidal Products): submission portal similar to REACH-IT
- IUCLID(5.5): Format of submission of scientific dossiers in biocides
- Coordination and assistance to MS processes
- Dissemination of information

- Getting familiar with ECHA IT tools is essential for succesful submissions
- Use plug-ins before submitting
