New version of REACH-IT to be released in **July 2012**:

- Limited to alignment with IUCLID 5.4:
 - Only accepts IUCLID 5.4 dossiers
 - No new data requirements in TCC until after the 2013 reg. deadline
 - Only one new Business Rule checking PBT assessment outcome
 - Invoicing of new conf claims (SDS)
 - Dissemination of new information (SDS)
- All other functionalities postponed for later:
 - On-line submission of DU notifications implemented as a new type of web form
 - Improvements needed in other areas
 - → Full integration of all processes in REACH-IT preferred (e.g. Evaluation, Inquiries)



IUCLID 5.4 just released: substantial changes!!

Submission to REACH-IT still with IUCLID 5.3 format until the new release of REACH-IT

- Section 3 revamped:
 - Restructure of uses according to life-cycle
 - Possibility to assign relevant uses (3.5) to registrant's sites (3.3)
 - Key Information from ES/CSR in section 3.7: transfer options to be added to Chesar and other tools to avoid manual typing
 - Biocidal information moved to section 3.8
- New structure for Endpoint summaries
- Other chemical names can be reported and a confidentiality flag is now available for the substance identity (1.1)
- → Will support transparency to i) avoid compliance feedback and ii) false positive substance selection by authorities
- → Requires technical solutions for transferring CSR information into IUCLID
- Important workload for industry: each company to decide strategy on when to include new info



IUCLID 5.4 just released: substantial changes!! (cont.)

- New form for information on mixtures (article 24 CLP) in section 14.2 (inquiry information moved to section 14.1)
- Improvements to C&L information in section 2:
 - Improved way to indicate classification
 - Multiple compositions linked to C&L blocks
- Dossier header includes now possibility to claim confidentiality on registration number
- New dossier header's types: application for authorisation, notifications for substances in articles, etc.

IUCLID 5.4 just released: substantial changes!! (cont.)

- Other improvements:
 - Increase the size limits of attachments (up to 512 Mb)
 - Folder structure to better organise dossiers and substances
 - New search criteria: by dossier type
 - Bulk user creation using .csv files
 - Improvement of user friendliness e.g. mouse functionality
 - Duplicated attachments are removed from the database
- New versions of all IUCLID plug-ins, compatible with IUCLID 5.4, to be made available in July (together with REACH-IT release)



IUCLID 5.5:

- Discussions on the scope just finalised at OECD
- Main modifications on:
 - Improvements on literature inventory
 - More search options
 - Enhancement in option to compare dossiers
 - Updated and new pesticides templates
 - New templates for nanomaterials
 - Biocidal Product plug-in
 - 2013 Registration deadline taken into consideration: no changes on REACH/CLP points ensuring full compatibility between IUCLID 5.4 and 5.5 for REACH/CLP submissions

IUCLID 6:

- IUCLID Management Group (OECD and ECHA) is collecting user requirements
- Currently focused on architectural changes
- Industry requirements will focus on:
 - Improved installation / migration
 - Additional functionalities / data structure
 - Enhanced performance and security
 - User interface
 - Documentation/training

New version 2.0 to be published by end June:

- No longer a IUCLID plug-in (IT-wise independent of IUCLID)
- •ECETOC TRA v3 and EUSES incorporated as exposure estimation tools
- Sector-specific GES and spERCs can be imported
- Possibility to reuse life cycle tree + assessment
- Generation of CSR (but not yet exposure scenario for communication)
- Stand alone and distributed version
- Release 2.1 foreseen for autumn

Future developments: (new versions expected later 2012)

- Update of CSR IUCLID plug-in to transfer data from Chesar to IUCLID and generate full CSR
- Consumer TRA (V 2.1 in autumn)
- Import of standard phrases into Chesar library (2.1 in autumn; depending on Escom development)
- ES for communication (V 2.2 late 2012 or early 2013); supports ESCOM XML
