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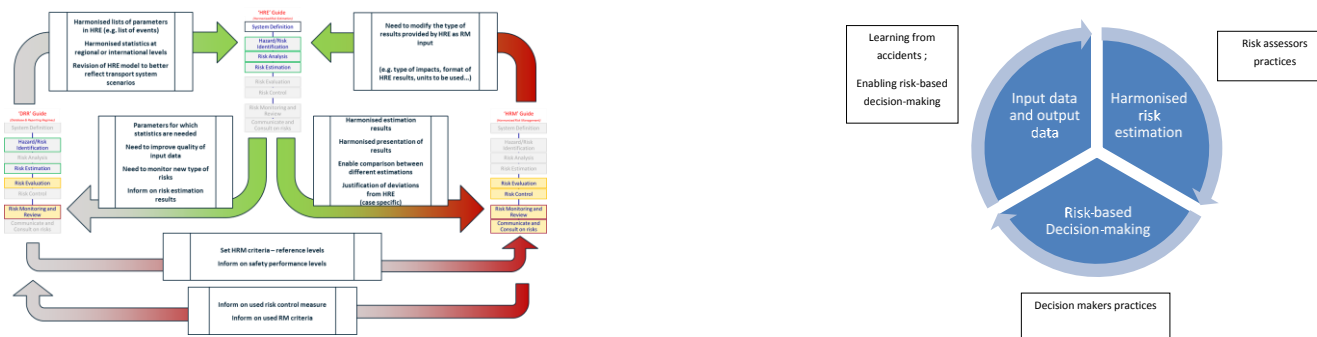
- › A background document setting the scene of the recurring TDG issues
- › A Study procured by EC on the feasibility to establish harmonised risk acceptance criteria in the context of inland transport of dangerous goods
- › EC Workshop on the Study (main) conclusions
  - Necessary to establish an harmonised Risk-management framework
    - Feasible
    - Best instrument: A new Directive
  - Stakeholder practices need to better converge, as a first step
    - Guidelines
- › Roadmap proposal made by ERA in 09/2014 ([Link to the roadmap proposal](#))
- › Support and collaboration of/with Joint-Meeting delegates and other Interested parties

- › A multimodal Risk management approach to TDG risks
- › An instrument to elaborate common solutions on recurring issues
