

European Responsible Care Awards 2016 | Judging criteria & timeline

All applications will be assessed by a panel of highly-qualified judges, including representatives from EU institutions, industry, trade associations and media. Our judges are Responsible Care thinkers and doers, even if you don't win, this is a great way to make them aware of your work.

The judges evaluate the entries based on the criteria listed for each category. As they read your entry, judges will be asking:

- How effectively does the project or initiative meet the specific criteria of the category entered?
 - Does the project ensure a cycle of continuous improvement?
 - Is the project well communicated to employees, local communities, other stakeholders and is it a best practice-sharing project?
 - Does the project show concrete facts and figures demonstrating the key benefits?
 - Is the project original and innovative?

- **Judging of all entries will take place in June and three winners will be selected.**
 - **All applicants will be notified regarding their applications during the week of July 4th, 2016.**
 - **Winners will be announced and receive their award on stage at the ceremony during our General Assembly to be held on October 7th, 2016 in Florence.**
